Early Years Nature Play

An integral element of the suite of opportunities our school provides to support our children's physical, emotional and academic growth is our nature playground. The playground, which has been built based on a narrative of Rooey the Kangaroo and his friends, is a specially designed play environment that consists of elements and textures



from the earth such as tree logs, tree stumps, boulders, hills, plants and drainage paths, with the addition of other man-made structures. The natural landscapes and challenging elements include materials that are not evenly spaced or predictable and lend themselves to providing opportunities for children to play, explore, use their senses, imagine and be challenged. Our play area invites open-ended interactions, spontaneity, risk taking, exploration, discovery and connection with nature - a great opportunity for children to build their confidence through play.

Excellence in Languages and Culture

Tolerance, understanding and cultural celebrations are an important part of our diverse school. Whitfield students come

from more than 25 different countries and speak just as many different languages in their homes. We hold a full accreditation to provide **international study programs** to students on visas as well as for school study programs and tours. These opportunities add strongly to the vibrancy and experience of our school language programs where students from years 3 to 6 study either **Japanese or Mandarin** on a weekly basis. A range of other cultural and language clubs further support the diversity of student learning.
